	East Sussex County Council (ESCC) Councillor: Cllr Keith Glazier  Keith had taken the highways steward round the area looking at the road problems. One of the recent landslides is still partially blocking Military Road. The landslip is the responsibility of the landowner who is required to come up with a design to remove and stabilise the cliff. This is awaited by ESCC.  Rother District Councillor: LH had no updates. PO mentioned that	
	there are community grants available. The Rother Council plan to 2040 is out for consultation.	
5	Neighbourhood Watch.  LH reported that there had been an increase in reported rural crime.

It was also reported that the railings next to the culvert near The Oasts had partially collapsed. The councillors discussed if it was necessary to replace these. 9	Correspondence:	
	The Clerk had received emails regarding the Parish Council's response to Rother District Council's Local Plan and had sent copies of the Parish Council's response to the parishioners who had asked for this.  A resident of Rye had questioned if the parish council was going to change their decision to not have a Neighbourhood Plan (NP). The councillors discussed this and concluded that they would not embark on the development of a NP.  It was noted that out of the thirty four parishes and towns in the Rother District Council (RDC) area only eight have a NP the last one being Peasmarsh this year. Three had started and have not proceeded. There are no further NP's in progress. (Source RDC). All the NPs completed need to be assessed again in 2026 to ensure they remain in line with RDC's new local plan.  The Clerk had received an email regarding changes to the bus services including the reductions to some services -revised timetables will be issued. There is a continuation of various fare reduction initiatives such as £1 off peak for children or 50p if with an adult.  The East Sussex Flexibus service has been altered having now a single zone instead of seven and a 14 mile maximum trip distance.
